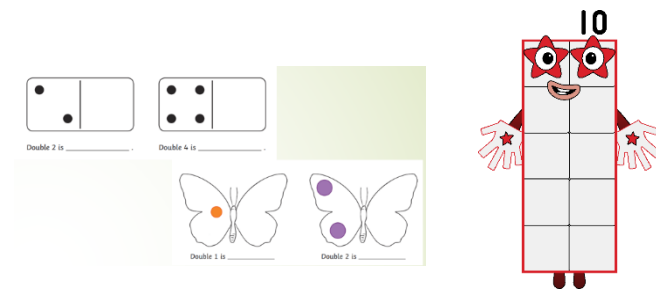




Sparrows & Wrens
