


Sparrows & Wrens

Ideas for at home:

Talk about people who are special to you and what you can do to make them feel special.

Continue to talk about the different jobs within the NHS and what they can remember.

Watch number blocks number 10 episode and talk about what they notice.

Talk about odd and even numbers and what they are - we have been thinking about this lots!

Help children to practice recognising and writing their sounds to be able to do this independently, and put these into words, captions and sentneces.

Help children to read their RWI book bag books, and share reading for pleasure books together, asking questions about what you read together, and get children to predict what they think might happen next!
