What we are learning about:

We will read 'The Little Red Hen', and follow instructions to make our own bread, before retelling how we did this by sequencing pictures.

We will look at a farmers' job role and why they are important, we will also look at scarecrows, explore fruit and vegetables and get involved in lots of arts and crafts around this.

We will continue our wanderlust learning this week with a linked theme of apples, exploring them in different ways, practising our cutting skills, and tasting apple juice, apples and apple pies!

Ideas for at home:

Talk about the food you are eating and where it might have come from. If it is a fruit or vegetable do they think it would be machine or hand-picked?

Talk about how things feel, or ask children to describe where things are rather than pointing to them.

Go on a walk and see what leaves you can find, are they changing? Talk about Autumn and how the leaves change and how the environment is changing with the season.
