

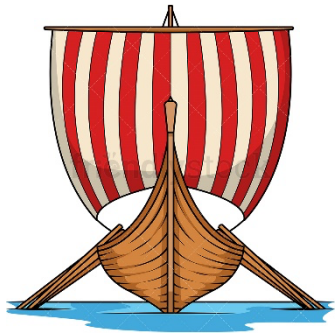
English Links

Our main text will be 'Viking Boy' by Tony Bradman. We will be using this alongside a range of non-fiction texts to inspire our writing. These will involve writing descriptions of battle scenes inspired by these various texts with our focus being on the characters, setting and atmosphere within a Viking saga.

We will be applying our knowledge of formal and informal writing to write a balanced argument about Anglo-Saxon and Viking life.

Our writing will also include the children producing a biography about someone who they find to be inspirational.

We will also be studying Old Norse poetry and using Kennings to write our own.



Year 6 Summer Term Curriculum Overview

Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

History We will be developing our history skills, thinking about the significance of events, identifying changes and posing our own historical questions during our learning on Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. We will be exploring life during those times using a range of sources, including artefacts.

Geography We will be exploring the geography of Scandinavia, including learning about trade links and energy sources.

Computing We will be developing our coding skills by designing our own adventure games as well as exploring how to use spreadsheets to compile data.

Global Citizenship - Understanding ethical dimensions of financial decisions.

Recognise connections and interdependencies between local and global issues.

Understand the importance of resolving conflict fairly.

Physical Education

We will be learning the skills of net and wall games in PE. This will be on a Tuesday and children should continue to wear their PE kit for school.
