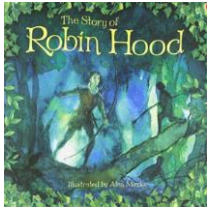


Year 3 Autumn term 2023

Novel Study



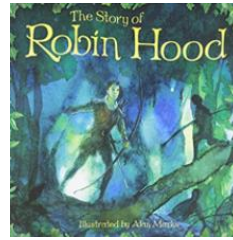
We will be beginning our Novel Study by joining Robin Hood and his Merry Men! We will read this wonderful story and immerse ourselves in the life of an outlaw.

As we learn more about forests we will explore our local area and think about the plans Doncaster has for its future. We will help Robin Hood to create a new settlement thinking about what is essential to be able to live there.

During this term we will also focus on letter and number formation as well as all letter joins during our handwriting sessions.

Modern Foreign Language

Children will begin to learn French this term. They will begin to learn the numbers to 10 initially and how to say hello, goodbye, how are you in the target language.



Foundation Subjects

Science - Plants Whilst exploring possible settlements for Robin Hood children will consider different types of plant life available in their chosen forest and explore the requirements of plants for life and growth.

Geography Children will be able to identify features of maps and apply their map skills. Through our Novel children will explore our local area using old and new OS maps and creating our own version of an OS for a small area of Auckley. Children will then focus on the problem of deforestation formulating their own opinions to this global issue.

Art Children will focus on two artists Van Gogh and David Hockney. We will research their styles and techniques, then look to replicate these elements in our own forest picture

Computing Children will research Sherwood Forest and present their findings.

Music We will be exploring sounds, choosing instruments and listening to sounds all around us.

Mathematics

- ✚ Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- ✚ Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and words
- ✚ Count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100
- ✚ Find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- ✚ Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones)
- ✚ Add and subtract numbers mentally, including: a 3 digit number and ones, a 3 digit number and tens, a 3 digit number and hundreds
- ✚ Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits using formal written methods.
- ✚ Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers
- ✚ Solve problems including missing number problems using number facts, place value and more complex addition and subtraction

Global Citizenship and RE

- Global Citizenship will run throughout our Topic work focusing on formulating and expressing our own views on current global issues.
- **Judaism-** What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?

Home Learning

- **Reading:** Please read **at least** 5 times per week to an adult. Adult please sign the planner each time your child has read. This can also include your child accessing bug club out of school.
- **Bedrock:** You will be given your Bedrock login details in Autumn 1. Please complete one session of Bedrock a week at home (this can be classed as one of your 5 reads per week so remember to write it in your diary!
