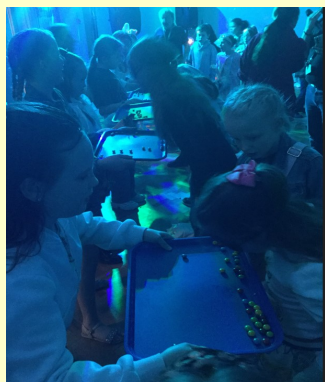
OUR TERRIFIC FRIENDS OF HAYFIELD LANE TEAM

We didn't just open the doors for PARENTS EVENING this term, we also held the following events:

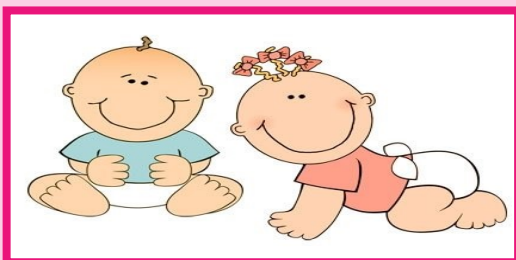
