If your child wants their egg back they will need to collect them at last break on 28th March.

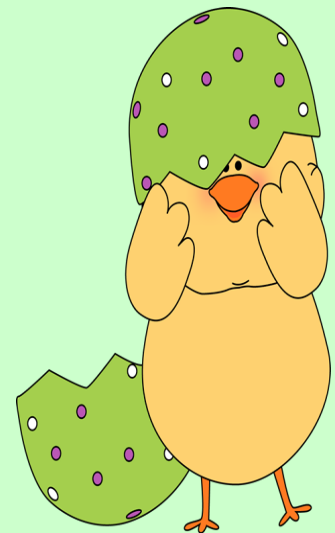

WORLD BOOK DAY
