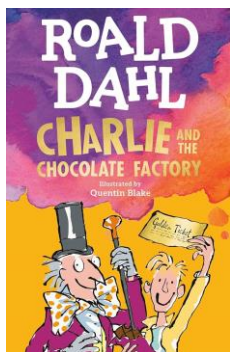


Novel Study
