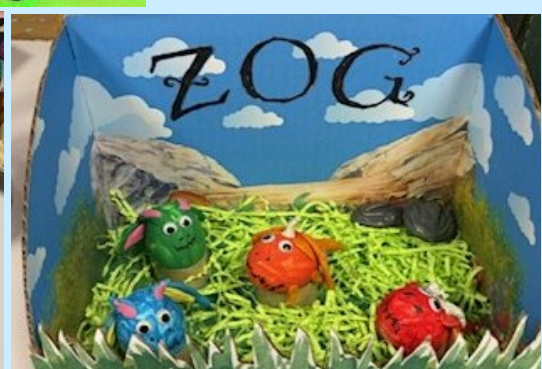
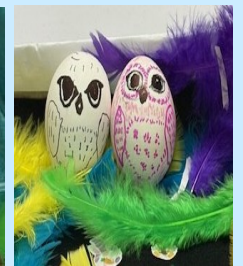
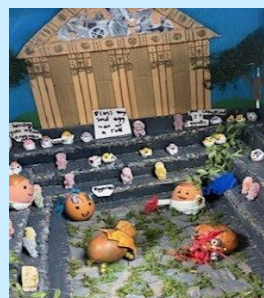
## SHEFFIELD CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL- HAYFIELD LANE FUNDRAISING.

As you know, we have been decorating a lion cub which will form part of a trail in Sheffield which will raise much needed funds for Sheffield Children's hospital. Take a look at him! He is brilliant and is covered in the birds that represent each class in school. There are also yellow Yorkshire Y's on there too. Our target was to raise £1000 however in true Hayfield Lane style, our children have really driven this further. A year 5 group arranged a community bake sale and raised a whopping £351.92 from their estate. The school bake sale raised £615. Mrs Law's Jellycat bunny raffle raised £522, Mrs Radford's painting auction raised £157.15, the non-uniform day raised £490.70 and the BEAT SCOTTY inflatable assault course challenge raised £2915. **As you can see, we raised well above the £1000 target, reaching over £5000, which is being taken to Sheffield and presented to the Children's Hospital this afternoon.** We thank all of our parents and INCREDIBLE CHILDREN for such outstanding contributions, including wonderful cakes that were baked. This money will make such a difference to support the Children's hospital

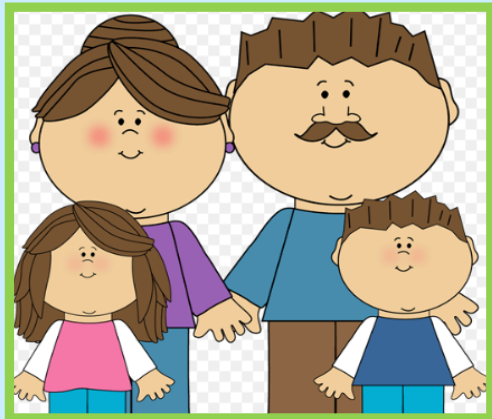
