



What we are learning about:

This week we will with Jack and the Beanstalk, focusing on our comprehension skills, talking lots about the story, setting and characters.

We will think about how the characters feel, and if it was all the Giants fault. This will bring in our managing feelings skills as well as looking at relationships and how to be a good friend.

We will read the alternative story of "Trust me, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks!". This is the story from the Giants point of view - and will get us thinking about how it doesn't feel nice for him!

We will make wanted posters for Jack who stole all the Giants belongings, make traps to catch that pesky Jack, and create our own 3d beanstalks in lots of different ways!

Because Jack stole to help his mum on the farm, we will look at farms today, and compare this to what farms looked like in the past, when there were no tractors and machines to help the farmers!
